

Larry Milton Campbell Memorial 4-H Scholarship

The Larry Milton Campbell Memorial 4-H Scholarship was created in honour of the late Larry Campbell, who retired after 38 years of service with the Canadian Meat Council. The Canadian Meat Council and 4-H Canada are proud to sponsor two (2) scholarships, valued at \$2,500 each, for 4-H members in their last year of high school or CEGEP who are planning to attend a Canadian university in September 2016 in Food Science, Meat Science or Animal Science and has his/her roots in farming.

Eligibility:

- Applicants must be at least 16 years of age by January 1, 2016 and a current 4-H member in good standing.
- Applicants must be Canadian residents in their final year of high school or CEGEP, have roots in farming, and plan to attend a Canadian university in September 2016. Applicants must be pursuing education in Food Science, Meat Science or Animal Science.
- Complete the on-line application form at <http://apply.4-h-canada.ca> and include the following:
 - Transcript of marks for the past academic year showing their numerical grade average in percentage form (i.e. 85%)
 - A 500-word essay outlining **how having roots in farming has made them who they are today**
 - Two reference letters from your community, school or 4-H leader
 - Background on their 4-H and community involvement
 - A letter of offer or acceptance to a full-time program in a Canadian university
 - Answer the question "How will this scholarship benefit you in achieving your educational goals?"
- Winners must agree to provide a photograph, proof of acceptance and their social insurance number in order to claim their award; funds will not be released until these documents are provided.
- Applicants must grant permission to Canadian Meat Council and 4-H Canada to use their name/and or photograph, province of residence, university and area of study in publications and through communications channels to promote the Larry Milton Campbell Memorial 4-H Scholarship.
- Scholarship recipients must be available to attend a scholarship presentation in their home community or suitable location in conjunction with a Canadian Meat Council representative(s).

Selection Criteria:

Applications will be reviewed by a Selection Committee and judged on the following criteria:

- Ability to follow instructions and meet deadlines
- Quality of the essay submitted
- Reference letters provided
- 4-H involvement (including number of years, positions held and projects completed)
- Community involvement
- Answer to the question "How will this scholarship benefit you in achieving your educational goals?"

In the event of a tie, winners will be selected by a random draw.

Online applications - must be received no later than 11:59pm EST on May 31, 2016.

Winners will be announced by July 8, 2016.
