

Saputo and Armstrong Cheese 4-H Dairy Club Fund 2019 Guidelines



4-H Canada, in partnership with [Saputo](#) and [Armstrong Cheese](#), is pleased to announce a new opportunity for registered 4-H dairy clubs (cow and goat) in Canada. This grassroots level support will offer 4-H members registered in these dairy clubs the opportunity to participate in learning opportunities and competitions, developing their confidence and knowledge relative to this industry. With the support of Saputo and Armstrong Cheese, our goal is to help young 4-H members reach their full potential as today's generation of dairy leaders.

Funding available

10 awards of \$1,000 each will be available to 4-H dairy clubs in Canada.

Eligibility

- Applications must be from the key leader of a registered Canadian 4-H dairy club (cow or goat) in good standing.
- Funds must be used by March 31, 2020.
- Any club that receives funding must commit to:
 - recognizing the partners (Saputo and Armstrong Cheese);
 - engaging the partner in their activity, when possible;
 - being available for a photo opportunity with the partner if partner is unable to attend the activity;
 - submitting a report, with photos, to 4-H Canada within 30 days of the completion of the activity.

Activities eligible for funding include, but are not limited, to:

- club support to attend or send a competing team to the Royal Agricultural Winter Fair, Canadian Western Agribition or similar exhibition;
- clinics or workshops to support dairy education (such as clipping, grooming, showmanship);
- new equipment for club use (such as clippers, grooming supplies, halters).

Exclusions

This fund will not support:

- programs and/or projects that benefit one individual;
- capital projects/capital expenditures (machinery, buildings and refurbishment costs, other);
- registration fees for anything other than those related to the activity itself.





Applications

Applications will open on August 15, 2019 and must be submitted online at apply.4-h-canada.ca.

Applications must be received by 4-H Canada no later than **11:59 pm ET on September 30, 2019**.

4-H Canada does not assume responsibility for any computer errors. The applicant is solely responsible for confirming that their application has been received.

Successful applicants will be notified by October 28, 2019.

Reporting

Projects are expected to be completed no later than March 31, 2020. An online report must be submitted at apply.4-h-canada.ca within 30 days of project completion. Further reporting details will be provided upon confirmation of funding.
