

# Canadian Co-operative Wool Growers 4-H Scholarship

## 2020 Application Guidelines



The Canadian Co-operative Wool Growers 4-H Scholarship was created to support interest in and the advancement of the Canadian sheep and wool industry. The Canadian Co-operative Wool Growers and 4-H Canada are proud to sponsor two (2) scholarships, valued at \$500 each, for 4-H members who are planning to attend a Canadian university or college in September 2020.

### Eligibility

- Applicants must be at least 16 years of age by January 1, 2020 and a current 4-H member in good standing.
- Applicants must have applied to university or college, with a preference for an agriculture-based program, ideally with a focus on sheep related studies.
- Applicants must complete the online application form at [apply.4-h-canada.ca](http://apply.4-h-canada.ca) and include the following:
  - Answers to all questions in the application
  - Background on their 4-H and community involvement, demonstrating interest in the advancement of the Canadian sheep and wool industry
  - A letter of offer or acceptance to a full-time program in a Canadian university or college for September 20
  - Answer the question "How will this scholarship benefit you in achieving your educational goals?"
- Applicants must grant permission to Canadian Co-operative Wool Growers and 4-H Canada to use their name/and or photograph, province of residence, university or college and area of study in publications and through communications channels to promote the Canadian Co-operative Wool Growers 4-H Scholarship.
- Scholarship recipients must be available to attend a scholarship presentation with a Canadian Co-operative Wool Growers representative(s) in their home community or suitable location.
- Recipients must not have received this scholarship in the past and must not be related to a current Canadian Co-operative Wool Growers Board member.
- Recipients must agree to provide a photograph, proof of acceptance and their social insurance number in order to claim their award; Funds will not be released and announcements will not be made until these documents are provided.



### Selection Criteria

Applications will be reviewed by a Selection Committee and judged on the following criteria:

- Ability to follow instructions and meet deadlines
- Demonstration of interest and advancement of the Canadian sheep and wool industry
- Community involvement, including extracurricular activities and how they relate to their educational and career goals
- 4-H involvement (including number of years, positions held and projects completed)
- Answer to the question “How will this scholarship benefit you in achieving your educational goals?”

In the event of a tie, winners will be selected by a random draw.

### Online applications

**Applications open at 10:00 a.m. ET on March 2, 2020 and must be received no later than 11:59 p.m. ET on May 31, 2020.**

Winners will be notified in July 2020 and public announcements will be made in August.
